- Booker T. Washington High School - New Facility for 1,300 - 1,500 Students (\$51 Million)
- North Early College High School - New School for 400 Students (\$13.5 Million)
- South Early College High School - New School for 400 Students (\$13.5 Million)
- Early Childhood Center - New Facility for 500 - 600 Students (\$23 Million)
- North Forest High School - New Facility for 1,300 - 1,500 Students (\$59 Million)
