



ST. LOUIS CARDINALS BUSCH STADIUM

The team of Hunt Construction Group in association with Kwame Building Group (Hunt/**KWAME**) was responsible for construction management of the new St. Louis Cardinals Busch Stadium.

This state-of-the-art professional baseball stadium was constructed partially on the site of the old stadium it replaced. Using a phased construction approach, the team began construction on the new facility during the 2005 baseball season - managing site constraints as well as safety and access issues.

Upon the completion of the 2005 season, Hunt/**KWAME** managed the demolition of the old stadium and completed construction of the new Busch Stadium in time for opening day of the 2006 baseball season.

KWAME's role as a sub consultant for Hunt was to provide personnel and professional services to the design-build team as the associate contractor. **KWAME** managed the general contractors and provided the team with project managers, project engineers, superintendents, project control specialists, document control specialists, and project administrators.

KWAME also implemented an innovative mentor/protégé program to ensure high levels of M/WBE participation.

The scope of the project included demolition of the existing Busch Stadium, construction of a new baseball stadium, utility relocation, street works and site development.
